

EDAS REACH YP – How We Use Your Information (Privacy Notice for Young People)

We know your personal information is important – and we want you to know how we look after it.

Who are we?

We're EDAS – a charity that supports people with things like drugs, alcohol, mental health, and learning and we provide the REACH YP Specialist Substance Misuse Service.

We're responsible for looking after any personal information you give us. This might include things like your name, date of birth, contact details, or information about the support you're getting.

Where is your information stored?

• If you're getting support from EDAS REACH YP, your information is stored safely in a secure system called **HALO** (used across Dorset).

All of this is done in line with data protection law to keep your information safe and private.

Who can see your information?

Only people who need to see your information will have access to it – like your support worker.

- If you're getting support, we may share some information with other trusted services in Dorset if you've said it's okay.
- Some anonymous (non-personal) data is shared with NDTMS nationally to help improve services, but this can't be traced back to you.
- We never sell your information or use it for advertising.

Why do we need your information?

We only collect what's needed to:

- Give you the right support
- Help you with learning or qualifications
- Meet legal or funding requirements

We'll always let you know why we're asking for something and whether you can choose not to give it.

腹 Your rights – What you can ask us to do:

- **See your info** You can ask what information we have about you.
- **Correct your info** If something's wrong or missing, we can fix it.
- **Delete your info** In some situations, you can ask us to delete your data.
- **Move your info** You can ask us to send your data somewhere else.
- Say no You can say no to your data being used in certain ways (like marketing).
- Ask us to stop You can ask us to pause using your info while something is being checked.

Some requests can't be done straight away (for example, if you're still working with us or we're legally required to keep records), but we'll always explain why.
